	<p>Old Business</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Cyber Etiquette Education (All Students) The plan for SY 2025-2026 is for “Tech Time” to be included in the middle school rotation, or elementary specials, and/or Advisory time. 2. Healthy Eating Education Program (All Students) Healthy food choices are addressed in PE classes; Middle/High school students take health/PE, and the nurse collaborates with the PE Department to emphasize healthy eating. 3. Substance Abuse & Tobacco Prevention Education (Middle & High School Students) Drug Abuse Prevention is addressed in the health curriculum in all grades; It was suggested to recognize DARE (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) possibly by a local DEA Agent. 4. Grade 6 Lunch Plan Discussion Student Council met with the Base Commander 2 years ago to establish Commissary privileges for students; Student Council needs to meet with students and stakeholders to discuss the issue of disrespect toward Commissary employees, litter (leaving unfinished drinks at the store or in lockers), and poor food choices and possible options. It is possible that the current Commissary Manager has not been informed about having a special section of healthy food choices; and our New Base commander will need to weigh in on the lunch policy. <p>Previous issues addressed: Clarification for Water Issues Incirlik AFB conducted a second round of Water Sampling. The elementary side of the building was found to be metal-free. Traces of heavy metals were found in room 33 (science room); these water sources are not potable drinking water; pipes are scheduled to be replaced.
